CPUC TO HOLD WORKSHOP ON UTILITY EXECUTION OF 2020 PSPS EVENTS

SAN FRANCISCO, March 11, 2021 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), in ongoing actions to reduce the impacts of utility Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS), will hold a public workshop on the operations and performance of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E), and PacifiCorp during the 2020 PSPS events in California.

WHAT: Joint Investor-Owned Utilities 2020 PSPS Workshop

WHEN: Monday, March 29, 2021, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

WHERE: Remote access via webcast or conference line. Participation information is below.

WHY: The CPUC is requiring utilities to publicly address their execution and performance of PSPS events during last wildfire season. At this workshop, PG&E, SDG&E, and PacifiCorp will provide information on their 2020 PSPS performance, including lessons learned and improvements planned in preparation for the 2021 wildfire season. The workshop will include an afternoon session with two roundtable discussions covering local governments, tribes, and the Access and Functional Needs community. Southern California Edison will join the afternoon session. The utility previously reported to the CPUC on its 2020 PSPS events at a public workshop on January 26 and provided an update on its Corrective Action Plan on March 1.
